



Field Trips

Spring is fast approaching, which means....field trips!!

Here a few reminders to help each trip to be enjoyable and SAFE:

PERMISSION FORMS

- All district parental permission forms must be completed prior to the trip.

WATER

- If the field trip involves entering the water, a currently certified lifeguard must be present—this includes the use of motel pools on overnight field trips.

CHARTER BUSES

- Charter buses need to be pre-approved by the North Coast Schools' Insurance Group. Check with your district or NCSIG for the pre-approved list. (www.ncsig.org/services.php—on the bottom of the page)

PRIVATE VEHICLES

- Due to the current budget situation, more schools are relying on private vehicles for field trip transportation. Keep in mind the additional liability that the district is accepting with this form of transportation. Well meaning volunteers do not have the expertise of a school bus driver, and their vehicle is not as safe as a school bus. Do not have field trips just because “this is what we do every year”. Check your district’s policies and procedures for private vehicle use. Private vehicles should be checked for safety prior to the trip. The driver’s automobile insurance should be checked prior to the trip. Non-district personnel transporting students should be fingerprinted before they are alone with students.
