

## Region 1 USDOE Emergency Response and Crisis Management Grant for Schools

Humboldt County Schools received an Emergency Response and Crisis Management grant from the US Department of Education in cooperation with the following counties; Mendocino (LEA), Del Norte, Lake and Sonoma. The grant was completed June 2007.
